



The ENVIRONMENTAL NOTICE

from the Savannah River Site

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RCRA modification requested

The U.S. Department of Energy-Savannah River Operations Office has requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) a modification to Savannah River Site's 1988 Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit Renewal Application, Volume X, which details operations of the Site's Consolidated Incineration Facility (CIF).

This revision (Rev. 16) ties the ancillary transfer pipeline from the solvent tanks to the incinerator burner skid piping, modifies the piping from the blowdown tanks at the ashcrete treatment unit at the point where the blowdown is added, clarifies the pH range for aqueous waste stored in the incineration feed

tanks, and modifies the kiln auxiliary drive type to be used.

This notice begins a 60-day comment period. More information, including the actual permit application, is available for review and copying at the DOE Public Reading Room located in the University of South Carolina-Aiken library, or by contacting personnel listed below. The permittees compliance history during the life of the permit being modified is available from the Agency contact person.

A public meeting will be held August 6 at 3:00 p.m. at the Aiken County Public Library. Representatives from SRS will be available to answer questions.
