DOE makes temporary request to modify F Area injection system

The Department of Energy (DOE) at the Savannah River Site has requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) a temporary authorization request to modify the F Area injection system.

The modification includes temporary use of well FIN-10. As currently permitted, the injection system does not have sufficient capacity to continue operating at the required flow rate. This temporary authorization will allow the F-Area groundwater treatment unit to continue operating at the required flowrates until the injection wells can be redeveloped.
