



Environmental Assessment (EA) Being Prepared for the Safeguards and Security Upgrades for Storage of Plutonium Materials at Savannah River Site (SRS)

Several actions must be taken to provide adequate safeguards and security for plutonium materials currently stored at SRS. These actions include deinventory of a building in F Area, construction and operation of the Container Surveillance and Stabilization Capability (CSSC) project, installation and operation of interim (prior to operation of CSSC) surveillance capability, physical security upgrades in K Area, and modifications at the Advanced Tactical Training Area to allow training of protective force personnel in new weapons and tactics.
