Notice of Intent to File a Permit Application with South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control For the Savannah River Site's 288-F Landfill Expansion

The Department of Energy (DOE)-Savannah River Operations Office has requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental control (SCDHEC) modification of the Savannah River Site (SRS) 288-F solid waste landfill permit.

The landfill is located in F-Area of SRS in Aiken County. The nearest town is Jackson, South Carolina, which is approximately five miles from the landfill. The proposed modification is a vertical expansion that will allow an additional 176,096 cubic yards of coal ash waste to be placed into the landfill; this is the only waste placed into this landfill. A request was submitted October 1, 2008 to SCDHEC for a determination that there is a need for the landfill expansion. The request noted that the proposed expansion is exempt from the county/region waste management plans pursuant to S.C. Code Section 44-96-290 (F) per Part IV, H.1.b.1 of Regulation 61-107.19 as the landfill is dedicated to waste ash generated on SRS property. Local zoning, land use and other such ordinances are not applicable as SRS is under jurisdiction of the federal government.

The proposed landfill expansion meets the buffer requirements set forth in Part IV, B.1.a. of Regulation 61-107.19. There are no residences, schools, day-care centers, churches, hospitals, or publicly owned recreational parks located within 1,000 feet of the landfill or on SRS property.
