Industrial Wastewater General Closure Plan for the F-Area Tank Farm Waste Tank Systems Available for Public Comment

Background:

The United States Department of Energy (DOE)-Savannah River Operations Office has requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) approval of the Industrial Wastewater General Closure Plan for F-Area Waste Tank Systems to support removal from service of underground radioactive waste tanks and associated ancillary equipment located in the F-Area Tank Farm (FTF) at the Savannah River Site (SRS). This General Closure Plan (GCP) establishes the protocols by which DOE intends to close FTF waste tank systems at SRS.

Plan Availability:

More information, including the GCP, is available for review and copying at the DOE Public Reading Room located in the Gregg-Graniteville Library at the University of South Carolina-Aiken. A public meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 21, 2010 at 6 p.m. at the Aiken Municipal Center, 214 Park Avenue, SW, Aiken, SC. Representatives from SRS and SCDHEC will be available to summarize the plan and answer questions about it. The purpose of the meeting is to provide information that will be helpful in understanding the GCP and in making any comments on the GCP.
