United States Department of Energy Savannah River Operations Office Hazardous Waste Permit Application Modifications Request

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE)-Savannah River Operations Office has requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) modifications to Savannah River Site's (SRS) 1992 Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit Renewal Application for Volumes IV and V, F- and H-Area Hazardous Waste Management Facilities (HWMF).

Modifications to Volumes IV and V (Revision 25 of the 1992 application) propose to add eight seepage sampling locations along Fourmile Branch and add the Enhanced Anaerobic Reductive Precipitation demonstration system at the F-Area Hazardous Waste Management Facilities (HWMF).

This notice begins a 60-day comment period. More information, including the actual permit applications, is available for review and copying at the US DOE Public Reading Room located in the University of South Carolina-Aiken library, or by contacting personnel listed below. The Permittee's compliance history during the life of the permits being modified is available from the Agency contact person.

A public meeting will be held **Wednesday, October 20, 2010, at 3:00 p.m.** at the Aiken County Public Library. Representatives from SRS will be available to answer questions. Written comments may be sent to SCDHEC. All comments will be considered in the final decision.
